*konzerva: can of food

kostým: woman's suit

košile (f): shirt

kouření (n): smoking

Verbs / Slovesa [if conjugations aren't given, you should know them already!]

chutnat + dat: to taste good to someone; like (a food or drink)

líbit se (líbí se; líbilo se) + dat: to like (be pleasing to someone)

milovat + acc: to love

nosit (nosím, nosíš...) + acc: to wear something (regularly)

oblékat se (oblékám se, oblékáš se...) + adv: to dress (in a certain way)

oblékat si / obléct si (obléknu si, oblékneš si...; oblékl si) + acc: to put on something (to wear)

prodávat / prodat (pro + dát!) + acc + dat: to sell something to someone

slavit (slavím, slavíš...) + acc: to celebrate something

zdát se (zdá se; zdalo se) + dat: to dream something

Adverbs / Adverbia

docela (dobře): quite (well)

hlavně: mainly, mostly

*uvnitř: inside

Prepositions / Prepozice

díky + dat: thanks to (usually positive)

k(e) + dat: to, towards

kvůli + dat: because of (usually negative)

naproti + dat: across from, opposite

proti + dat: opposite; against

Expressions / Výrazy

Šaty dělají člověka: Clothes make the man

mít na sobě + acc: to be wearing something (right now)

nejde mi X: I'm not good at X

sluší mi X: X suits me

Hodí se ti to?: Does that work for you?

vadí mi X: X bugs me

je mi zima/teplo: I'm cold/hot

je mi dobře/špatně: I'm good/bad
